I Am Called To Serve Jesus

ICEBREAKER

Tell us about a time when you served someone else and you felt fulfilled.

INTRODUCTION

The fourth purpose of my life is God shaped me to serve Him. We use the word "bless" to describe this. You bless God by blessing others. And you bless other people when you serve them. It may be physical assistance. It may be financial assistance. It may be emotional support. It could be relational support. It could be practical support. There are a thousand different ways that you can serve the people around you. Today, we will learn how serving others will impact our own lives.

READ |

We are called to be a blessing. We bless God by worshiping Him. But we also bless Him by blessing others through service. Paul said it this way.

Your faith in the Lord and your service are like a sacrifice offered to Him. And my own blood may have to be poured out with the sacrifice. If this happens, I will be glad and rejoice with you.

Philippians 2:17 (CEV)

Notice that Paul is okay with the heavy sacrifice that serving others causes him. That's because he knows that there is a greater joy to come in Heaven as God will reward every act of service we do for Jesus in our everyday lives.

The way we gain that joy is by first taking the focus off ourselves by serving others. Serving takes the focus off of you. It's helpful to understand that life, it's not all about you. It's about fulfilling your calling to serve others. **You were saved to serve Jesus by serving others**. The moment you became a Christian, God called you to serve.

Do you have a place of service in the church and your world? How can you serve Jesus by serving others each week?

READ |

Serving others brings us incredible joy and it also *improves our relationships*. This may be the most important aspect of being a blessing by serving because this is something we all need.

You see, the root of nearly every relational problem is selfishness. It may be your own selfishness or the other person, or both. There may be other problems along the way, but at the heart of our relationship problems is usually this...someone is more focused on their desires and preferences than the other. How do we cure this problem? Service is the answer! Read how Jesus modeled for us and instructs us to do the same as He did:

"Do as I did: The Son of Man did not come for people to serve Him. He came to serve others and to give His life to save many people."

Matthew 20:28 (ERV)

Last week we learned that we are called to become like Christ. Serving is part of that process. As we become more like Him by serving, we become more like Jesus. In fact a non serving Christian is a contradiction as we are all called to serve others.

What are some practical ways you can serve even when you don't feel like it?

READ |

Another benefit of being called to bless by serving is: **Serving others unselfishly will make my life meaningful**. The only way you find meaning in life is to give your life away. God wired the universe on this principle.

"If you cling to your life, you will lose it; but if you **give up your life for Me, you will find**it."

Matthew 10:35 (NLT)

Everything you do for Christ has a purpose. It may seem insignificant and maybe no one else seems to know about it but it's important. The Bible says that even if you give a cup of cold water in God's name, you get rewarded for that in eternity. Every single act of service you perform will be rewarded by God.

Jesus said if we give up our lives for Him, we will find it. And, He says He will reward us even for the menial tasks we do for Him. Please share what you think about each of these two benefits of serving Jesus? Have you been serving Jesus by serving others daily?

READ |

Finally, being a blessing by serving others will *leave a legacy*. What you do matters. It matters to God and it matters to others. You have no idea just how much of an impact your life will make.



- S Scripture
- O Observation
- A Application
- P Prayer

Here's an example:

S: Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.'"

--Matthew 4:4 (NIV)

O: Jesus said that we can't live on food alone. Our life is sustained through His Word.

A: Just as food is important to me, God's Word is even more because it will sustain me and give me the strength to live out my life.

P: Jesus, thank You for reminding me that I need Your Word to give me the wisdom & strength to follow You. Help me to make time to spend with You daily. In Jesus' name I pray, amen.
